

### Summer Fete



## RECENT ACTIVITIES


### Fit Baw


### Maggie's Line Dancers


### Partick Pluckers

### Meet Mia



## OUT & ABOUT


### Transport Museum

### Golden Friendships



### Jesse Turns 90


We had a very special birthday recently, where our fabulous Jessie turned 90! Everyone had a great time celebrating this very special occasion with her!
